OVERVIEW OF RESPONSIBILITIES/DUTIES:

- Reports directly and is accountable to the Executive Director/designate
- Oversees the repair, upkeep and maintenance of an organization's assets and properties.
- Plan, organize, direct, control and evaluate construction projects
- Collaborate with vendors and contractors, and coordinate with tenants, to expedite completion of work
- Maintain building systems by contracting for repairs and service, and prepare specifications for competitive bids on larger maintenance projects and service agreements
- Manage daily property requirements and plan capital improvements by regularly inspecting properties for damage and inefficiencies
- Perform grounds work, including but not limited to grass cutting, hedge trimming, pruning, planting flowers/weeding, raking, snow blowing, etc.
- Adheres to Occupational Health and Safety requirements
- Ensure compliance with Public Health Inspector, Fire Inspections, etc.
- Maintain accurate records regarding preventative maintenance, work orders, inventories and purchase orders
- Occasional emergency on-call
